Ld. Lawyer for the accd.1.Azad SK, 2. Suresh Chand files a separate petition and prays for bail for accused, 1 Azad SK, 2. Suresh Chand who has been in custody, u/s 20(b)/25 of NDPS Act, since 07.11.2018 alongwith co accused, namely, Dinesh Pandey whose bail was granted by Hon'ble Calcutta High Court Circuit Bench AT Jalpaiguri, vide its Orders No. CRM(NDPS) 57 of 2023 dated. 07.02.2023 .

Perused the prayers.

Heard from both sides.

Considered.

After considering the facts and materials on record, F.I.R. and in view of Orders being No. CRM(NDPS) 57 of 2023 dated. 07.02.2023 of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court In the Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri, the present bail prayer for accuseds, namely, 1.Azad SK, 2. Suresh Chand are allowed, on same footing, on condition that the petitioners shall furnish bond of Rs. 10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned C.J,M, Jalpaiguri.

The petitioner shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of the trial court during the entire period of trial and shall attend the trial on each and every date.

The petitioner shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case so as to dissuade such person from disclosing such facts to any police officer or the court and/ or tamper with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.

Perused.

Petitioner may furnish the bail bond.
