Today is fixed for appearance and order.

Both the petitioners, viz. Debasish Mukherjee and Smt. Sushmita Mukherjee are present along with their respective Ld. Counsel. They filed a joint petition, u/o.23, Rule-3, read with sec.151 C.P.C, supported by an affidavit and have prayed for permission to withdrawal of the present suit. They stated in their petition that they filed the present suit, u/s.13B of the H.M. Act, praying for divorce on mutual consent. But now, they settled the matter and want to live together as husband and wife under the same roof. The court personally asked both the parties on dock and they concedes to such fact that due to misunderstanding, the instant suit was filed but at present, they want to live together as husband and wife.

After considering the above facts and circumstances and as both the parties want to withdraw the suit, so there is no bar to allow the petition of the petitioners under such provision.

Hence,

it is ordered

that the petition, u/o.23, Rule-3 stands allowed on consent.

The petitioners are hereby permitted to withdraw the present case without any liberty to file the suit afresh.

The instant suit is hereby disposed off accordingly on consent of both the parties.
