Today the case is fixed for ex-parte hearing.

Petitioner files hazira.

At this stage, Ld. Advocate for the O.P. files a written statement along with a petition for taking off the case record from ex parte board and also with a petition for acceptance of the written statement.

Firstly, the petition for taking off the case record from the ex parte board is taken up for hearing. I find that the O.P. has filed the written statement along with a petition for acceptance of the written statement of O.P

I am of the view that for proper adjudication of the instant case an opportunity should be given to the OP for contesting the case on merit and thus the interlocutory petition for acceptance of W.S. should be disposed of first before proceeding with the main case.

Hence, the case is taken off from the ex parte board. Accordingly, the petition for taking off the case from ex parte board is allowed. Thus the matter is shifted from the ex parte board and be fixed for hearing the petition for acceptance of the W.S.

Now, the petition for acceptance of W.S.O. by O.P is taken up for hearing.

Heard.

I am of the view that O.P. should be given an opportunity to contest the case on merit as they have filed the Written statement.

As the O.P. has filed the written statement so, the same is accepted. Let the same be kept with the record. Hence, the petition for acceptance of W.S. is **allowed**.

Hence, the matter be fixed for Reconciliation.
