**NDPS Case No. 82/2018**

**08.01.24**

Convict Sultan Ali (A-1) and Pradunnya Shil (A-2) are produced from jail custody physically.

Accused Sultan Ali and Pradunnya Shil are found guilty and they are convicted under section 20(b)(ii)(C) r/w section 29 of NDPS Act.

I have heard the convict (A-1) and (A-2) and the learned Advocate for both the sides on the point of sentence u/s 235(2) Cr.P.C. and their pleas are recorded on separate sheets and tagged with the case record.

The accused abovenamed prayed for lenient punishment considering their liabilities.

Considering all aspects, convicts Sultan Ali (A-1) and Prdaunnya Shil (A-2) are sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 10 (ten) years and also to pay a fine of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh) each i/d to undergo further simple imprisonment of 3 (three) years for the offence punishable u/s.20(b)(ii) (C) r/w. 29 of the NDPS Act, which, in my opinion, will meet the ends of justice in this case.

The period of detention already undergone by the accused during investigation and trial shall be set off from the sentence of imprisonment. The sentence shall run concurrently.

Seized contraband is confiscated to the State and be destroyed immediately following due procedure of law.

The Chairperson of the Drug Disposal Committee, Kamrup(M), Guwahati be communicated for doing the needful.

Seized truck bearing fake registration number AS-25-BC-1811 corresponding to original registration number TR-01-U-1814 is confiscated to the State u/s.60 of the NDPS Act and is liable to be disposed of u/s.52A(1) of the NDPS Act.

Seized Driving License, Aadhar Card, Pan Card, Voter ID, Cash amount, ATM cards be restored to the possession of the original owner.

Let a certified copy of this judgment be furnished to the accused free of cost, immediately and the accused is informed about their right of preferring appeal against the judgment and order of conviction and sentence of this Court.

Let a copy of this judgment be forwarded to the District Magistrate, Kamrup (M), Guwahati in compliance with the provision laid down u/s. 365 Cr.P.C.

Judgment is pronounced and delivered in the Open Court in presence of accused reading out the operating part. Judgment is prepared on separate sheets and tagged with case record.

Case stands disposed of on contest.
