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ORDER.

05. 06.04.2026. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned P.P. for the State on anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Baheri P.S. Case No. 56/2026 registered for offences U/Ss 126(2), 115(2), 74, 324(4), 303(2), 110, 351(2), 352(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

As per FIR, prosecution case in short is that on 24.01.2026 at about 05 PM when the informant and her mother were going to see her field and when the informant and her mother reached at the field and saw that accused persons namely Puja Devi, Ganesh Sada, Mamta Devi, Savitri Devi, Pramila Devi and Meena Devi were heftily harvesting the crops from the field of the informant. It is further alleged that when the informant saw them, they tried to fled away from there. It is

further alleged that upon protesting the informant, accused Ganesh Sada ordered to kill her and accused persons started assaulting her and accused Savitri Devi snatched golden Mangalsutra from the neck of the informant's mother. It is further alleged that on 25.01.2026 at about 02 PM when the informant's brother namely Hariom Kumar was returning from his school then in the meantime accused persons started assaulting him and also took away Rs. 3,000/- from the pocket. Upon hearing hulla, informant and her brother came to save him then accused persons also assaulted them and also snatched the wrist watch from the hand of the informant's brother. They threatened the informant to face dire consequences. Nearby people came there and took the informant and her mother to the DMCH for better treatment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. It has further submitted that petitioners have been implicated in this case due to some ulterior motive and also to put pressure upon the petitioners. It is further submitted that as a matter of fact the present case has been filed as a counter blast and by way of defence to the case filed by the petitioner Pooja Devi against the informant and others vide Baheri PS Case No.55/2026 against the prosecution party. He further submitted that the case has been compromised in between the parties. He further submitted that no occurrence did ever take as alleged in the FIR. He further submitted that no specific overt act of assault is alleged against accused petitioners. He further submitted that now matter is amicably settled in between the parties and a join compromise petition has also been filed in this case. The informant of this case namely Archana Kumari is appeared before the court and supported the factum of compromise. She has also filed an affidavit in this regard. He further submitted that accused petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is therefore, prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P. P. opposed the prayer for bail of the

petitioners.

From the perusal of FIR, it appears that accused petitioners and others assaulted the informant, her mother and brothers and committed theft. There is case and counter case in between the parties. The doctor has found only simple injury caused by hard and blunt substance over person of injured Rekha Devi and Hariom Kumar. The case is compromised in between the parties and a joint compromise petition, duly signed by both parties, has also been filed. The informant of this case namely Archana Kumari is present in the court and she supported the factum of compromise in between the parties. She has also filed an affidavit in this regard. The I.O. of this case in para-13 of the case diary has stated that accused petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The case is under way of investigation.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case discussed above, the instant petition for anticipatory bail of Petitioners is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of 30 days from the receipt of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) B.N.S.S. with further condition that one of the bailor shall be close relative of the accused petitioners and accused petitioners shall file an affidavit that they will not to commit such occurrence in future and they will cooperate in the investigation/trial of this case.
