J U D G E M E N T

- (1) The present applicants have filed present bail application under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, seeking regular bail in connection with the FIR No.I No.11192050260624/2026, lodged with Sanand Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 305(a), 331(3), 331(4) of B.N.S.
- (2) The learned advocate representing the applicants has argued that we are falsely involved in the case and just on the basis of suspicion, we are arrested. The entire muddamal is recovered from us. Hence we are not needed for any custodial interrogation. In that case, considering the other submissions made in the bail application, we may be granted regular bail.
- (3) The learned DGP has submitted that the applicants are habitual offender and police has made a recovery of amount from their possession so the bail may be rejected.
- (4) I have considered the submissions advanced by the learned advocate for the applicant, the learned DGP for the State, the FIR, the investigation papers and the affidavit filed by the Investigating Officer. The applicants are charged for

house breaking and amount of theft is Rs.49,000/- as per the affidavit. Where the police has recovered sum of Rs.12,000/- from the accused and that established prima facie involvement of the applicants in the case. Though the offence is triable by JMFC court, but police affidavit also suggests that applicants have criminal antecedents. I have considered all the facts. In that case, if we consider the present bail application in context to settled parameters for consideration of bail such that whether there is any prima facie or reasonable ground to believe that the accused had committed the offence; nature and gravity of the accusation; severity of the punishment in the event of conviction, danger of the accused absconding or fleeing, if released on bail, character, behaviour, means, position and standing of the accused; likelihood of the offence being repeated; reasonable apprehension of the witnesses being influenced and danger, of course, of justice being thwarted by grant of bail, etc. then I am of the opinion that bail should be granted to the applicants. Accordingly, I pass the following order:

-: O R D E R :-

- [1] The present regular bail application filed by the applicants named **Badalbhai Rahulbhai Vanzara (Banjara) and Badalsing Shravansing Tank** is hereby allowed.
- [2] The applicants/accused **Badalbhai Rahulbhai Vanzara (Banjara) and Badalsing Shravansing Tank** are hereby ordered to be released on regular bail in connection with

FIR bearing C.R. No.11192050260624/2026, lodged with Sanand Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 305(a), 331(3), 331(4) of B.N.S., on furnishing personal bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) each and surety of like amount, before the trial Court subject to following conditions:

- (1) The applicants/accused shall furnish their permanent residential address along with proof and their contact number before the Court and to the I.O. of concerned Police Station and in case of any change therein, they shall immediately inform to the Police and shall declare their new address in writing before the trial Court at the earliest.
- (2) The accused shall regularly remain present before the Trial Court.
- (3) The applicants/accused shall not take undue advantage of their liberty.
- (4) The applicants / accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity.

[3] Yadi be sent to the concerned Police Station.
