

HDFC Bank Vs. Kuldeep Ram

Present: Proxy counsel for complainant.

Proclamation issued against the accused has been received. The period of 30 days has already elapsed. Accused did not put appearance. Accordingly this court is of the considered view that he/she is absconding. Hence the accused is declared proclaimed person. Intimation regarding accused being absconding/proclaimed person be sent to the SHO concerned through the Naib Court for making entry in his relevant register and also directed to register FIR under Section 209 BNS as per rules against the accused. The learned counsel for the complainant stated at bar that the preliminary evidence of complainant be treated as evidence under Section 335 BNSS. He further stated that at present he does not want to furnish any list of property of accused. Since the list of property of accused has not been furnished proceedings under Section 85 of BNSS cannot be initiated against the accused. File be consigned to the record room and will be taken up again as and when accused is arrested or surrenders or complainant furnishes some list of properties.
