

NDPS Case No. 75 of 2024

Order No. 01 dated. 04.12.2024

Received two accused persons, namely, 1.Rahul Singh, 2. Roshan Sankar who are brought under arrest by Bhaktinagar PS case no.1134 /2024, dt. 04.12.2024, u/s 21(c)/25/29 of NDPS Act. alongwith documents in connection with. Bhaktinagar PS case no.1134 /2024, dt. 04.12.2024, u/s 21(c)/25/29 of NDPS Act.

Seen the F.I.R., Formal F.I.R. forwarding report alongwith , memo of arrest, Seizure list,medical papers and accused challan and they are taken into custody and remanded to J/C till 18.12.2024.

One separate petition for bail is filed, on behalf of the accused persons namely, 1.Rahul Singh, 2. Roshan Sankar by Ld. Advocate and prays for bail.

Ld. P.P. In-Charge also present today. Strong objection has been raised by the Ld. P.P-in-Charge regarding bail application.

Heard from both sides.

Considering the facts and circumstances, , the bail prayer, for the accused persons, namely, 1.Rahul Singh, 2. Roshan Sankar, is rejected, at this stage.

One prayer for police remand of accused persons, namely, 1.Rahul Singh, 2. Roshan Sankar, is filed by SI,Maheshwar Ch. Paul of Bhaktinagar PS, duly forwarded by I/C Bhaktinagar PS and recommended by A.C.P., WEST Zone-II of SMC, respectively.

On perusal of the CD, I find that the accused persons had made statement and to work out the information I am of the view that police custody is necessary otherwise the prosecution would be unable to bring the actual fact before the court.

Considering the material facts of the case, the prayer for police remand is allowed for 5 days, on condition to abide by the guidelines of the Hon'ble Apex Court as laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in D.K. Basu's Case and the directives as of NHRC and produce the accused before the court after completion of police remand on **09.12.2024** with report.
