

Criminal Misc. Case – 1868 of 2026

Order No. 15, dated – 23.07.2026,

The application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, Prapti Biswas, praying for anticipatory bail in connection with Bhaktinagar P.S. Case No.982/2025 dated 06.10.2025 u/s- 108/3(5) of the B.N.S., PTN No.WBJP02P006043/2025, is taken up for hearing.

I.O. is personally present along with C.D. and P.M. report and his personal appearance is exempted.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail petition has ever been filed in connection with this case before any higher Court on any earlier occasion and an affidavit has also been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner in support of such contention by the Ld. Defence Lawyer and the Ld. P.P, Jalpaiguri conceded to the fact as submitted by the Ld. Defence lawyer.

It is a case of the accused-petitioner that she has been falsely implicated in this case out of personal grudge and vendetta and misunderstanding. It has been also contended that the accused-petitioner is not in relationship with the alleged incident in any way as it has been narrated in the written complaint. Furthermore, the accused-petitioner is a college student and law abiding person and pursuing her academic activities. Over and above, investigation is in much progressed stage. Considering the present facts and circumstances of the case and stages of investigation, the accused-petitioner may be granted with anticipatory bail subject to any condition with a promise to cooperate with the investigation.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri, appearing for the State has submitted that P.M. report has been produced and the same is lying in the C.D. which will speak for itself regarding the nature of death. However, he has also submitted that it is a result of failure of love affairs. He also submitted that CDR has not been collected and no suicidal note has also been left by the deceased before his death. However, he has submitted that investigation is in much progressed stage and necessary order may be passed.

Heard both the sides.

Perused the T.C.R and the case diary. Considered.

Upon perusal of the T.C.R. and the C.D. as submitted by the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri, and also after going through the record including the written complaint, F.I.R. and other incriminating materials lying in the C.D. including the P.M. report, inquest report etc. and considering the submissions of the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri appearing on behalf of the State, it appears to this Court that there was an allegation of abetment of suicide by the accused-petitioner upon the victim who happened to be the boy friend of the accused-petitioner. However, considering the present facts and circumstances of the case and stages of investigation which is much in progressed stage, at this stage, this court does not find any justification for custodial interrogation of this accused. In view of that, this Court is inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail subject to certain conditions.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the instant anticipatory bail application filed by the above-named accused-petitioner stands allowed.

Accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest, the accused-petitioner, namely, Prapti Biswas, shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two (2) sureties of Rs.5000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, subject to the compliance of the condition as laid down in sub-section (2) of Section 482 of B.N.S.S. and on further condition that the accused-petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation as and when required till completion of investigation and submission of chargesheet, i.d. necessary order will be passed.

Send a copy of this order along with T.C.R. to the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Return C.D.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
