Challan presented today. Report of Ahlmad perused. It be registered. Copies of challan under Section 207 Cr.P.C supplied to accused.

Since the offence against the accused is bailable offence, therefore, the accused are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Accused has stated that he could not arrange surety bonds today itself and he be released on personal bonds and some time may be given to him for furnishing the surety bonds. In view of the said request, accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/-. Personal bonds furnished, which have been accepted and attested.

Heard and perusal of challan report under Section 173 Cr.PC and the documents annexed thereto shows that a prima-facie case under Section 61 of Excise Act is made out against the accused. Let charge under Section 61 of Excise Act be framed against the accused.

Charge framed against the accused, to which, he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. Let PWs @ Sr. No. 2 & 8 be summoned for 21.02.2025.
