This case is referred to the Lok Adalat Organized by the Taluk Legal Services Committee, Rasipuram under Section 19 of the Legal Services Authorities Act (Act 39/1987) coming on before us for endeavors for settlement of the dispute between the parties, being the subject matter of this case, in the presence of the parties and their counsels, and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the case, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decreed in terms of settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsels herein having, in acceptance of the same signed this in our presence, it is decreed/ordered.

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed for settlement of the dispute for a sum of **Rs.10,05,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh Five Thousand Only)**. The Respondent/s is/are directed to deposit the settled amount before the competent Court through NEFT/RTGS within Six weeks from the date of this award, failing which the respondent/s has agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit.

Apportionment:

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the Sections 21/22 E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the Court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEFT/RTGS, as per the directions of the High Court of Madras, in C.M.A.No.428/2016.

The Court fee paid shall be refunded to the parties in the manner prescribed under Section 69 A of the Tamil Nadu Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955 (as amended by the Tamil Nadu Act 44 of 2007 with effect from 2.5.2008)
