PW Sunil Kumar, T.A, O/o Income Tax Department is present and suffered the separate statement to the effect that :-

“Stated that summoned record does not exist with our department/Income Tax Department in a different building rather it is with the TDS Commission and the address of said department is Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS) Central Revenue Building, Sector 17-E, Chandigarh. I may be discharged and concerned official may kindly be summoned”.

In view of above said statement, notice to concerned official from Commissioner of Income Tax (TDS) Central Revenue Building, Sector 17-E, Chandigarh be issued for next date of hearing. PW Sunil Kumar, T.A stands discharged.

Today, counsel for the plaintiff has again requested for an adjournment. However, said request not opposed by opposite party. In the interest of justice, now **one more last and final opportunity** is granted to the plaintiff for concluding its entire evidence on **23.04.2026** failing which the evidence of plaintiff will be closed by very order of the Court and cost of Rs.500/- shall be imposed in that eventuality.

It is observed that in order to accommodate the action plan laid down by the hon'ble high court and to prioritize disposal of five-year-old cases and cases pertaining to senior citizens, adjournment in the present matter is granted, the same is not opposed by either party.
