Accused, Nitai Sarkar is personally produced from J.C.

A bail petition has been filed on behalf of above-named accused person by the Ld. LADC praying for bail on the ground stated therein.

Heard submission of the Ld. LADC and also Ld. Public Prosecutor-in-charge.

Perused bail petition and the report submitted by the Superintendent of Jalpaiguri Central Correctional Home.

It appears from the report that the accused-petitioner requires medical treatment as he is mentally ill as per opinion of the Board of Doctors. The accused-petitioner is in custody for more than 07 months. The old mother of the accused-petitioner is present in court and she has submitted that she wants to take her son for better treatment. Considering the medical report, I am of the view that if a son is only under care of the mother, it may help the accused-petitioner to get recovered from the mental illness as has been reflected in the medical report.

Considering the period of detention, medical report and also considering the fact that immediate trial of this case is not possible, I am inclined to enlarge the accused-petitioner on interim bail till next date.

Accordingly, accused-petitioner, namely, Nitai Sarkar may find **Interim bail** on furnishing P.R. Bond of Rs.2,000/-, as the accused-petitioner is represented through Ld. LADC, **till 06.05.2026**, subject to satisfaction of the learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri, on condition that he shall attend the court proceeding on each and every date as fixed i.d. to J/C.

If on bail, 06.05.2026 for appearance of the accused person.
