Matter is listed today for filing of regular bail
application by accused Bishu Kumar/scrutiny of documents.

It is stated by Ld. counsel for accused Keshav Kumar
and Bishu Kumar that scrutiny of documents is complete.

Ld. counsel for A-1 has filed an application under
Section 207 CrPC. Copy supplied. **HIO is directed to appear in
person with directions to supply the deficient documents,
mentioned in the application under Section 207 CrPC, to A-1 on
NDOH.**

In terms of previous order, regarding his appearance in
the medical exam on LDOH, accused Bishu Kumar has filed his
roll number alongwith the date sheet.

Ld. counsel for accused Bishu Kumar has filed an
application to under Section 483 BNSS seeking grant of regular
bail. Copy of the same has been supplied to Ld. PP for the CBI.

The application is orally contested by Ld. PP for the
CBI. It is stated by Ld. PP for the CBI that he has no objection in
allowing the present bail application filed by the accused Bishu
Kumar.

Arguments on the bail application have been heard.

Perusal of the file reveals that accused Bishu Kumar was not arrested during the investigation. Charge sheet has already been filed. No purpose will be served by detaining him in custody at this stage. Therefore, **in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, accused Bishu Kumar is admitted to bail on furnishing of his personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the conditions that: -**

- (i) accused/applicant shall not indulge in the offence/s of the same nature.
- (ii) accused/applicant shall not influence the witness/s and shall join the further investigation and appear in the court as and when directed to do so by the authorities concerned.
- (iii) accused/applicant shall not hamper with the further investigation, if any, in any manner.
- (iv) accused/applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of this court.

Bail application stands disposed of.
