Matter is listed today for filing of bail applications as well as scrutiny of documents.

It is stated by Ld. counsel for accused Keshav Kumar that scrutiny of documents is complete.

Ld. counsel for accused Abhishek Raj has filed application to furnish bonds under Section 91 BNSS alongwith bail application under Section 483 BNSS. Copy of the same has been supplied to Ld. PP for the CBI.

The application is orally contested by Ld. PP for the CBI. It is stated by Ld. PP for the CBI that he has no objection in allowing the present bail application filed by the accused Abhishek Raj.

Arguments on the bail application have been heard.

Perusal of the file reveals that accused Abhishek Raj was not arrested during the investigation. Charge sheet has already been filed. No purpose will be served by detaining him in custody at this stage. Therefore, **in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, accused Abhishek Raj is admitted to bail on**

**furnishing of his personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the conditions that: -**

- (i) accused/applicant shall not indulge in the offence/s of the same nature.
- (ii) accused/applicant shall not influence the witness/s and shall join the further investigation and appear in the court as and when directed to do so by the authorities concerned.
- (iii) accused/applicant shall not hamper with the further investigation, if any, in any manner.
- (iv) accused/applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of this court.

**Bail application stands disposed of.**

Requisite bonds on behalf of accused Abhishek Raj have been furnished. The same are considered and accepted. Stamped copy of online FDR be retained on record. Concerned bank be intimated and directed to mark a lien on the said FDR and file a compliance report before the court.

Ld. counsel for accused Bishu Kumar that he could not appear as he is having medical exam in his college. He is directed to file his roll number alongwith the date-sheet. In case, accused fails to file the proof regarding his appearance in medical exam today, cost of Rs. 5,000/- would be imposed upon the accused on NDOH.

Put up for filing of regular bail application by accused Bishu Kumar/scrutiny of documents on **22.05.2026**.
