

Gurpreet Singh @ Mahajan versus State of Punjab

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed by bail applicant/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Mahajan son of Sarabjit Singh, resident of Khokhar, Ghanie Ke Bangar, Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Section 483 of BNSS for regular bail.

2. FIR No. 156 dated 23.10.2025 under Sections 21 (C) of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Kalanaur on the ground that accused Navjot Singh and Gurpreet Singh @ Mahajan were arrested on 23.10.2025 by the police party of P.S. Kalanaur and 2 kilo 80 grams of Heroin has been recovered from their possession. During investigation, accused Sukhmandeep Singh, Rajandeep and Suman have been also nominated in this case under Section 29 of NDPS Act vide Rapt No. 15 dated 24.10.2025 and Rapt No. 27 dated 27.10.2025.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has put in appearance on behalf of State and opposed the bail application. Main file perused.

4. Allegations against the applicant/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Mahajan are that he along with co-accused Navjot Singh was arrested on 23.10.2025 and 2 kilo 80 grams of Heroin has been recovered from their possession. During investigation, three accused Sukhmandeep Singh, Rajandeep and Suman have also been nominated. Challan in this case has been presented. Main file is pending in this Court and same has taken up for disposal of this bail application. Though it is argued that investigation has been completed, but completion of investigation cannot be considered

as sole ground to grant bail in this case to the bail applicant accused. Allegations against the bail applicant/accused are very serious nature. Commercial quantity of Heroin has been recovered in this case. As such, rigors of Section 37 of NDPS Act have been attracted in this case. Case is at its initial stage and as such, bail applicant/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Mahajan is not entitled for bail at this stage. Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed being without merits. It is made clear that observation made herein above shall not construed as an expression on the merits of the main case. Bail application file be tagged with the main file.
