Both the wife and husband namely **Smt. Sikha Bhowmick** and **Sri Ranjit Debnath** are present by filling hazira. They filed their respective evidence in chief. They are examined as P.W.1 & P.W.2 respectively and discharged.

Self attested photocopy of Aadhaar Card of PW1 is marked as Exhibit-1. The original Marriage Certificate dated 17.06.2021 is marked as Exhibit-2. Self attested photocopy of Aadhaar Card of PW2 is marked as Exhibit-3.

The suit is taken up for hearing and disposal.

This is a Matrimonial suit u/s. 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 for divorce on mutual consent.

The fact of the case, in gist, is that both **Smt. Sikha Bhowmick** and **Sri Ranjit Debnath** are the wife and husband and the marriage between the parties was registered on **17.06.2021** as per Special Marriage Act, 1954. They lived as husband and wife and in the said wedlock no issue was born to them. The difference of opinion cropped up and they started living separately since after **08.02.2024**. The efforts for reconciliation failed. They have prayed for mutual divorce. Hence the suit.

Both the parties have narrated their case in their respective evidence in chief and deposed as P.W.1 & P.W.2. The statutory period of six months' waiting from the date of the presentation of the petition has already been expired and 18 (eighteen) months has not been elapsed. They have deposed before the court practically in chorus that the efforts for reconciliation failed as there is difference of opinion between them. I being the Court directed both parties in open court to reconcile their dispute but they have not agreed. That being the position, I feel inclined that there is no possibility of reunion between the parties and the instant suit is liable to be decreed.

The Court Fee paid is correct.



Hence it is,

O R D E R E D

That the **Matrimonial Suit no. 271 of 2025** be and the same is decreed on mutual consent without any cost.

The marriage registered on **17.06.2021** between the parties namely, **Smt. Sikha Bhowmick** and **Sri Ranjit Debnath** is dissolved by a Decree of Divorce on mutual consent from the date of this order u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act,1954.

The Marriage Registration Certificate No. WB64100100010100002165-2021-75946 dated 17.06.2021 stands **cancelled**.
