The instant Criminal Misc Case is arisen out of the bail application filed u/s 482 BNSS by the applicant/petitioners namely, **1) Shikha Singh, 2) Bimal Chandra Singh @ Bimal Singh**, both the resident of village & P.O. Kuchni, P.S. Sahebganj, Dist. Cooch Behar, in connection with G.R. Case No.276/2026, corresponding to Samuktala P.S Case No.47/2026 dt. 11.02.26, u/s 137(2)/140(3) of BNS.

Learned Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioners submits that the accused/petitioners have not moved any bail application for and on behalf of the accused before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court and no such application is pending or disposed of before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Heard the submission of Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioners who submitted that the accused/petitioners are the relative of the principal accused No.1 and there is no nexus in the alleged commission of offence, hence prays for anticipatory bail on any stringent condition.

Learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, raises formal objection and drawn the attention of the Court to the medical report at page nos. 18 & 19 and the statement of the victim so recorded by the Learned Magistrate u/s 183 of BNSS at page no.36 of the case diary.

Having heard the submission of Learned Advocate of both sides and on perusal of the case record and other materials on case diary specially the statement of the victim so recorded u/s 183 of BNSS, it is seen that there is no such incriminating materials against the present accused persons. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners namely, **1) Shikha Singh, 2) Bimal Chandra Singh @ Bimal Singh**, may find bail of **Rs.3,000/- each** with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting authority and on condition that they shall comply with the requirements as enumerated u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with LCR be sent to the learned CJM, Alipurduar for information and taking necessary action. A copy of this order be sent to the I.O.

Thus, the instant Criminal Misc case is disposed of.
