Record is put up on an application filed on behalf of the petitioner.

The petitioner has filed a separate petition with contention that the suit has been fixed for exparte hearing and the evidence of the case has already been completed on 28.08.2025, but since then no order has been passed.

Considering the contention of the petitioner the record is taken up for passing necessary order.

Perused the materials on record.

On perusal of the record, it appears that this is a suit under Section 27 of Special Marriage Act, 1954, filed by the petitioner against her husband for dissolution of marriage.

It is the contention of the petitioner that the petitioner got married with the respondent on 08.03.2018 by way of registration of their marriage under the provision of Special Marriage Act and after marriage they started to reside together as husband and wife. It is the allegation of the petitioner that after few days of their marriage the respondent and his mother and brother began to torture the petitioner on some false pretext and she was not provided with proper food and treatment and ultimately on 20.01.2022 the petitioner was driven out by the respondent from her matrimonial home on 20.01.2022 after being assaulted physically and hence this suit.

My predecessor in office has been pleased to fix the suit for exparte hearing against the respondent vide order dated 25.06.2025.

In support of the contention of the petitioner, the petitioner has adduced evidence as P.W.1.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and on perusal of the record, it appears to me that the testimony of the petitioner regarding her contention remains unchallenged and there is nothing on record to contradict her contention.

Considering the above, it appears to me that the petitioner is able to prove her case and is entitled to get the relief as prayed for.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the marriage took place in between the petitioner and the respondent on 08.03.2018 as per provision of Special Marriage Act is hereby dissolved by way of decree of divorce u/s 27 of Special Marriage Act.
