

Criminal Revision 13 of 2026

The case is fixed for filing requisites and for receiving TCR from Ld. J.M. 1st Court, Alipurduar.

The TCR has not arrived.

The learned Advocate appearing for the Revisionist Shyamal Roy moves a stay petition and seeks stay of all operations of the order of the Ld. Trial Court on the ground that without assigning just reason his client has been saddled with the burden of Rs.10,000/- to pay per month to the respondent No.1. He seeks for stay of the execution.

No requisites has been filed by the Revisionist till date. The order for filing requisite was passed on 02.06.2026. This conduct of the Revisionist shows that he is unwilling to provide maintenance to the respondent No.1. I am of the view that a blanket cover like stay should not be granted in this situation. The prayer for stay petition is rejected.

Revisionist is directed to put in requisites and inform the Respondents, today only.

The case is adjourned **to 05.08.2026 for hearing of the revision.**

A fresh requisition be made to the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Court, Alipurduar for sending the case record before the date as shown above.
