The instant Criminal Misc Case arises out of the bail application filed u/s 482 BNSS by the applicant/petitioners, namely, **1) Md. Sahajhan Shekh @ Sahajul, 2) Najbul Chowdhury @ Najimul Chowdhury, 3) Malika Khatun and 4) Manbhola Chowdhury @ Maidul**, all of them R/o North Point, Battala, P.S. & Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with G.R. Case No. 460 of 2026, corresponding to Alipurduar PS Case No. 90/2026, dated 06.03.2026, u/s 329(4)/126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/76/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Mr. Babul Saha, Ld. Counsel appearing for the accused/petitioners submitted that the accused/petitioners have not moved any bail application for and on behalf of the accused before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court and no such application is pending or disposed of before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Heard the submission of the Ld. Counsel for the accused/petitioners who submitted that the accused/petitioners are being falsely implicated in the present case and they are the resident of the locality within the jurisdiction of this Court. Hence, prays for bail on any stringent condition.

Mr. Suhrid Majumder, Ld. Public Prosecutor, raises formal objection and contended that this case is a result of case and counter case. However, the Investigating Officer has already served with the

notices of Section 35(3) of BNSS. The copy of which lying with the case diary.

Perused the case record and the case diary.

In view of the submission made by the Ld. Advocate of both sides and as the investigating Officer served the notices under Section 35(3) of BNSS, therefore, the need of custodial detention of the present accused/petitioners are minimum.

Thus, considering the above facts, the nature of allegation, the prayer for bail is **allowed**.

The accused/petitioners, namely, **1) Md. Sahajhan Shekh @ Sahajul, 2) Najbul Chowdhury @ Najimul Chowdhury, 3) Malika Khatun and 4) Manbhola Chowdhury @ Maidul** in the event of their arrest in connection with the above referred case, may find anticipatory bail of **Rs. 3,000/- each** with two registered sureties of **Rs. 1,500/- each**, subject to satisfaction of Arresting Officer with further condition that the accused shall meet the Investigating Officer as and when required and shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer, and shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court, on condition to abide by the provisions laid down under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with TCR be sent to the learned CJM, Alipurduar for information and taking necessary action.

A copy of this order be sent to the Investigating Officer along with CD.
