Record reveals that appropriate Statement of Truth has not been filed by plaintiff alongwith the present suit. Further, filed affidavit for electronic record documents is not in accordance with Order XI Rule 6 (3) CPC. Said defects are curable in nature.

Subject to curing the above said defects within period as directed above and subject to all just exceptions, issue summons of the suit to all the defendants at all available addresses, by all permissible modes on taking requisite steps for next date. Steps be taken within two week's time from the date of this order. The plaintiffs are also directed to file the affidavit of service on record.

Written statement has to be filed by the defendants within 30 days (extendable upto 120 days with the leave of the court and that too subject to appropriate terms) from the date of service of the process as per the Proviso of Sub Rule 1 of Order 5 Rule 1 CPC as applicable to the Commercial Courts Act.
