

SC. 5/18 (CIS 743/17)

Order dated 06.11.24

Today is fixed for evidence of CSW-17, Investigation Officer.

No SR of summons is received. No prosecution witness is present

Sole accused on court bail is present. Ld advocate for the accused is present. Ld PP -in-charge is present.

An application is filed by the Ld PP-in-charge submitting therein that CSW-17 investigation officer is not required to be examined. It is also submitted by the Ld PP -in-charge that no further witnesses shall be produced by the prosecution in connection with this case. The Ld PP-in-charge prays for closure of prosecution evidence.

On perusing the record it appears that the prosecution has examined the complainant, the father of the victim and few other witnesses. However there are witnesses such as relative of the deceased and medical officers who are yet to be examined. There are also material in the case diary banking on which charge has been framed under Section 498A/ 302 I.P.

C. though charge sheet was filed under Section 498A/306 I.P.C.

Considering the above aspects this court find it necessary to examine the entire list of prosecution witnesses for the purpose of trial and just decision of the case.

Fixing 09.12.2024 for evidence of C.S.W. 3 and 4 and 13.12.2024 for C.S.W. 12, 13, 14.

Issue summons.
