

Jai Singh Vs. Partap Singh

Arguments on the point of summoning heard. The complainant filed a complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act on the allegations that the accused had issued a Cheque No. 000086 dated 22.11.2020 amounting to Rs. 8,00,000/- in favour of the complainant in discharge of his existing liability which was dishonoured on the ground of “**Funds Insufficient**”. In his preliminary evidence the complainant himself stepped into witness box as **CW1** and submitted his affidavit as **Ex. CW1/A** and reiterated the allegations leveled in the complaint. The accused did not make the payment of the said cheque amount despite the service of legal notice which necessitated the filing of this complaint. Complainant proved the documents from Ex. C-1 to Ex. C-4 respectively. From the evidence referred above, there are prima facie sufficient materials on record to summon the accused under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. Let the accused be summoned accordingly for 24.01.2022 on filing copy of plaint etc.
