Steps be taken within in two weeks from today. DH is directed to file affidavit that there is no stay or appeal pending against the present execution petition alongwith the PF.

It is directed that Manager of the concerned bank

shall remit the said amount to the Court after attachment either in the form of bank draft or banker's cheque in the name of DH.
