This is an application U/S 482 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner namely, **Sabitri Das**, the resident of village Dakshin Kamakhyaguri, Bangla Chowpathi, P.S. Kumargram, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Kumargram P.S. Case No. 87/2026, dt. 19.04.2026, u/s 85/103(1) of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 791/2026.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner and submitted that this accused is falsely implicated in this case as being the mother of the principal accused; she has no any connection with the commission of the alleged offence; her custody is not required in this case; hence her prayer may be allowed.

Ld. Advocate for the accused further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before any higher forum.

Heard Learned P.P. who submitted that as per the materials with the CD, there are allegations against the principal accused who is the husband of the victim. There is no any such materials against the present accused; hence, he has nothing to say.

Perused the CD and gone through the statement of the complainant recorded under Section 183 of BNSS and it appears that there are allegations against the principal accused who is the husband of the deceased. The complainant has not stated anything against this accused in her statement recorded under Section 183 BNSS. I do not find any materials in CD to consider the requirement of this accused in J/C for the sake of investigation. Considering as such, her prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner **Sabitri Das** may find bail of **Rs. 6,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs. 3,000/-** each of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the fulfillment of the condition as required u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.

The bail application is, thus, disposed of.
