The instant Criminal Misc Case is arisen out of the bail application filed u/s 482 BNSS by the applicant/petitioners namely, **1) Gouri Roy, 2) Rakesh Roy @ Rakesh Yadav, 3) Manoj Roy**, all the resident of Sanjay Colony, Ward No.15, P.O. Alipurduar, P.S. Alipurduar, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with G.R. Case No.1099/2026, arising out of Alipurduar P.S Case No.209/2026 dated 19.05.26, u/s 126(2)/115(2)/75(2)/76/79/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Mr. Som Shankar Dutta, Ld. Counsel appearing for the accused/petitioners submitted that the accused/petitioners have not moved any bail application for and on behalf of the accused before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court and no such application is pending or disposed of before the Hon'ble High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners have entered into compromise with the defacto-complainant/victim and to that effect she has sworn in on affidavit stating their compromise for compounding of the offence. A formal order is sought for for grant of bail in favour of the petitioners.

Ld. Public Prosecutor has submitted that in view of the submission made by the petitioners and the materials on record specially the affidavit purporting for compounding of the offence necessary order may be passed. He has stated that injury report reflects simple injury.

Heard both sides.

In view of the above submission and after hearing the victim of this case for such compounding of the offence, the prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners namely, **1) Gouri Roy, 2) Rakesh Roy @ Rakesh Yadav, 3) Manoj Roy**, may find bail of **Rs.4,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.2,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on condition that they shall comply with the requirements as enumerated u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.

Thus, the instant Criminal Misc case is disposed of.
