This is an application U/S 482 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Gopal Kami**, the resident of Radharani Tea Garden, P.S. Kalchini, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Kalchini P.S. Case No.69/2026 dt. 28.05.26, u/s 46 B.E. Act, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1236/2026.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner and submitted that necessary seizure has already been made, further detention of the accused is not required, hence he may be released on bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Heard Learned P.P.

Perused the record and it appears that all necessary seizure is made in this case. I do not think further detention of the accused is required in this case. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner **Gopal Kami** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.5,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the fulfillment of the condition as required u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The bail application is thus disposed of.
