This is an application U/S 483 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Subhankar Pandit @ Suman**, the resident of Subarnapur Colony, Bholardabri, P.S. Alipurduar, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Alipurduar P.S. Case No.235/2026 dt. 27.05.26, u/s 46(c) of Bengal Excise Act, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1193/2026.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner and submitted that all the necessary seizure has already been made and custody of the accused is not required, hence his prayer may be allowed.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Heard Learned P.P.

Perused the record and it appears that all necessary seizure is made in this case. I do not think the further detention of the accused is required in this case. Hence, his prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

The accused/petitioner **Subhankar Pandit @ Suman** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.5,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Alipurduar.

The bail application is thus disposed of.
