This is an application U/S 483 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Dulal Dey**, resident of Haribari, Uttar Kamakhyaguri, PS-Kumargram, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Kumargram P.S. Case No.115/2026 dt. 25.05.2026, u/s 109/115(2)/117(2)/126(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1150/2026.

Ld. Advocate for the accused further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Heard Learned Lawyer for the accused who submitted that accused is an aged person of 62 years old; he is in J/C for considerable period; all the allegations against him are false; hence, his prayer may be allowed.

Heard Ld. P.P. and submitted that as per injury report the alleged injury is simple in nature and may be grievous. Hence, he has nothing to say.

Gone through the CD as well as case record. From the injury report it appears that the alleged injury is simple in nature. As per doctor the alleged injury may be grievous. From the report of the doctor it appears that the injury is not clear.

Considering as such and considering the age of the accused, I am inclined to release the accused on bail. Hence, his prayer is **allowed**.

The petitioner **Dulal Dey** may find bail of **Rs. 5,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs. 2,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Alipurduar.

The bail application is, thus, disposed of.
