This is an application U/S 482 BNSS filed by accused/petitioners namely **1) Smt. Anita Das @ Anita Das Mandal, 2) Smt. Puja Bhowmik, 3) Sri Prakash Mandal**, all the resident of Kunjanagar, Singpara, P.S. Falakata, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Falakata P.S. Case No.347/2026 dt. 23.05.26, u/s 85/115(2)/117(2)/351(3)/3(5) of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1136/2026.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners has contended that there is family dispute with regard to property and there is no allegation against the petitioners. Hence, they may be released on bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Learned P.P raised no objection submitting that the injury sustained by the victim is simple in nature.

Perused the case diary and the materials on record.

Perused the injury report of Pulak Das dated 13.05.26 and that of Puja Dasgupta dated 22.05.26. The nature of injury is stated as simple. The statement recorded u/s 183 of the BNSS does not necessitate custodial interrogation of the petitioners in this case. Therefore, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners namely, **1) Smt. Anita Das @ Anita Das Mandal, 2) Smt. Puja Bhowmik, 3) Sri Prakash Mandal**, may find bail of **Rs.4,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.2,000/- each** of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on condition that they shall comply with the requirements as enumerated u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
