This is an application U/S 483 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Swapan Das**, resident of Laskarpara, PS-Kumargram, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Kumargram P.S. Case No. 06/2026 dt. 04.01.2026, u/s 109/117(2)/126(2)/351(2) of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 32/2026.

Ld. Advocate for the accused further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Heard Learned Lawyer for the accused who submitted that both the complainant and the accused are relatives; there is a case and counter case between them and the matter had already been settled between the parties. Complainant is present before the Court and files his affidavit to the effect that he has no objection in granting bail to the accused since they have already settled their dispute. Hence, accused may be released on bail.

Heard Ld. P.P.

Complainant is found present before the Court and he stated that they are family members and they have already settled their dispute and he has no objection in granting bail to the accused.

Considered. Prayer is accordingly **allowed**.

The petitioner **Swapan Das** may find bail of **Rs. 3,000/-** with one surety, subject to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Alipurduar.

The bail application is, thus, disposed of.
