This is an application U/S 482 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Sri Anup Das**, the resident of Sonatikari, Chand Para, Gaighata, P.S. Bangaon, Dist. North 24 Parganas, in connection with Alipurduar P.S. Case No.204/2026 dt. 18.05.26, u/s 318(4)/336(3)/338/340(2) of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1084/2026.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has contented that the petitioner after receipt of notice u/s 35(3) of the BNSS turned up before the Investigating agency and fully cooperated and that even after interrogation by the Investigating agency he was not arrested and that he is regular employee of the local body and that he may be released on pre-arrest bail on any condition.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Ld. P.P has fairly submitted that necessary order may be passed and as pointed the page numbers of the case docket for perusal of this Court. Ld. P.P further submitted that the death certificate was applied and cancellation was effected even before starting of the instant case.

I have gone through the case docket and as seen at page nos. 34,36,38,41 & 65 of the case docket. The materials on the case docket does not warrant the custodial interrogation of the petitioner in this case. Therefore, the prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner **Sri Anup Das** may find bail of **Rs.4,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.2,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on condition that he shall comply with the requirements as enumerated u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
