Debasish Sarkar...accused/petitioner -Vs- State of W.B.

Order No.2, dt.01.07..26.

This is an application U/S 482 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Debasish Sarkar**, the resident of Modakpara, P.O. Bholardabri, P.S. Alipurduar, Dist. Alipurduar, in connection with Alipurduar Women P.S. Case No.46/2026 dt. 12.06.26, u/s 117/85 of BNS, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1362/2026.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner and submitted that accused is falsely implicated in this case. He is innocent. He has duly complied with the notice u/s 35(3) of the BNSS. His custody is not required. Hence, his prayer may be allowed.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner further submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Heard Learned P.P.

Perused the CD and it appears that accused has duly complied with the notice u/s 35(3) of the BNSS. I did not find anything so as to require the detention of the accused for the purpose of investigation. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner **Debasish Sarkar** may find bail of **Rs.3,000/-** with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the fulfillment of the condition as required u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The bail application is thus disposed of.
