Accused Lachman Mahaly @ Laxman is produced from the Correctional Home.

Mr. Dulal Ghosh, Ld. Defence Counsel, appears for the accused.

Mr. Suhrid Majumder, Ld. Public Prosecutor is also present.

No witness is present.

An application for bail has been filed on behalf of the accused Lachman Mahaly @ Laxman.

The record is taken up for hearing of the bail application.

Mr. Ghosh, Ld. Counsel moves the bail application submitting *inter-alia* that the accused has been detaining in the custody since 10.07.2025. Ld. Counsel further submits that the investigation is completed and four witnesses have already examined by the prosecution.

Ld. Public Prosecutor raises no objection against the bail prayer.

Heard.

Considered.

The charge has been framed under Sec. 64(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and the prosecution has examined four witnesses including the victim girl.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the *prima facie* materials available on record, I am of the considered opinion that, further detention of the accused is not required. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is allowed.

The accused **Lachman Mahaly @ Laxman** may find **interim bail** of Rs. **2,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.1,000/- each**, on condition that the accused shall not leave the jurisdiction of this Court and shall appear on each and every date, subject to satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M., Alipurduar.

The bail petition, is, thus, disposed of.
