Order No.03, dt. 02.07.2026 :

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners, namely, **1) Sk. Mintu @ Sk. Ansar, 2) Sk. Sahalam @ Sahalam Mallik and 3) Tapas Roy @ Sukumar Roy**, praying for anticipatory bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners submits that except Section 109 of B.N.S., all other sections are bailable and Magistrate triable and there is no ingredient to attract Section 109 of B.N.S. These accused-petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. As such, he has prayed for enlarging the accused-petitioners on anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. P.P refers the C.D and raises objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 of B.N.S.S., medical report and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. It appears from the case record that it is a case u/S- 109/115(2)/117(2)/126(2)/3(5)/351(2) of B.N.S. Nature of injury as mentioned in the injury report is only assault, which suggest the injury is not so serious.

Considering the materials on record, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused-petitioners is not highly required and accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioners is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused-petitioners namely, **Sk. Mintu @ Sk. Ansar, Sk. Sahalam @ Sahalam Mallik and Tapas Roy @ Sukumar Roy** be released on bail by executing bond of **Rs. 5,000/-** each with two registered sureties of **Rs.2,500/-** each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer. The accused-petitioners to comply the provisions u/S-482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.

C.D. & T.C.R be returned.
