Accused Rajib Roy @ Arup Roy is produced from JC on virtual mode.

Today is fixed for hearing of bail application.

Ld. PP In charge and Ld. Advocate for the accused are present.

The bail application is taken up for consideration.

Heard the ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused, who submits that the accused is in custody since 30.10.2024 and is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Advocate prayed for bail on any condition.

Ld. PP in Charge raises objection.

Heard both side.

Perused the relevant materials from the case record.

Admittedly there was love affair between the victim and the accused.

Considering the statement of witness and the PM report and also considering the period of detention, I find justification in releasing the accused on bail.

Hence, the accused Rajib Roy @ Arup Roy may find a bail of Rs. 7,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 3,500/- each, subject to satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Jalpaiguri, with further condition that the accused shall attend this court on each and every date. Further, he shall not threat or induce the witnesses in this case, in any manner.

Fix 11.06.2025 for appearance if on bail and consideration of charge.
