

IN THE COURT OF THE ADDL. DISTRICT JUDGE, MALBAZAR, JALPAIGURI

Both the petitioners namely, **Suraj Gour** and **Diksha Kumari Prasad** are present before the Court along with their Id. Advocates. Record is taken up for hearing as per submissions of both the Id. Advocates.

Before proceeding with the hearing of the application u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 the case record is taken up for reconciliation. This court took its best endeavour to reconcile the dispute between them, but parties were too arrogant to settle the dispute between them. Hence, reconciliation fails.

Now, the petition u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act is taken up for hearing and delivery of judgement.

The petitioners No.1 and No.2 are examined as P.W.1 and P.W.2 in full and discharged on 04.06.2026. Some documents are marked as exhibits.

This is an application u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954.

It transpires that the marriage between the parties were solemnized on 21.01.2024 by way of registry marriage, under the Special Marriage Act. After marriage, the parties resided as husband and wife at the house of the petitioner No.1 till 25.08.2024. The marriage was consummated. It further appears that since 25.08.2024 parties have been living separately and there is no chance of reconciliation. The parties have no other alternative but to break their marriage tie and that there is no collusion between them and there is no claim whatsoever against each other. No issue was born due to wedlock.

In view of above, this court is of view that there is no impediment in passing a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

Court Fees paid is correct.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

That the **Mat Suit No. 714 of 2025** be and the same is decreed on mutual consent in favour of the petitioners. There is no order as to costs.

The marriage tie between the parties, namely, **Suraj Gour** and **Diksha Kumari Prasad** solemnized on 21.01.2024 by way of registry marriage is hereby dissolved on mutual consent u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 with effect from this day.

The marriage certificate being No. WB32800103021300502163-2023-169044 dated 21.01.2024 stands cancelled.

Parties are directed to inform Razzak Hossain, the Marriage Officer of Baganbari, Jalpaiguri Sadar, Jalpaiguri with immediate effect.

Let a copy of this order be supplied to each of the parties free of cost as per provision of section 34(4) of the Special Marriage Act, 1954.
