

HDFC BANK LTD. VS.

Present: Sh. Manoj Kumar, Advocate for complainant.

Non bailable warrants issued against the accused received back un-executed. Counsel for complainant has come present and made a statement that the address mentioned in the complaint is the last known address of the accused as per the last updated KYC details of the accused and other documents available with the bank and he stated that accused is intentionally not appearing before the court and presence of accused may kindly be procured through coercive method. Heard. In view of aforementioned statement, it is presumed that accused has full knowledge with regard to pendency of present case and is intentionally avoiding the execution of non bailable warrants. The presence of accused cannot be procured except by way of coercive method. As such, in order to avoid any further delay, time and energy, this Court finds it proper to procure presence of accused through proclamation for **14.10.2026** with the direction to the process serving constable to get it **effected on or before 07.09.2026**, as follows:-

- (a) it shall be publicly read in some conspicuous place of the town or village in which such person ordinarily resides;
- (b) it shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the house or homestead in which such person ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of such town or village;
- (c) a copy thereof shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the Court-house.

Further, complainant is directed to furnish the details of property, bank account or salary of accused person for the purpose of carrying out proceedings of attachment under Section 85 of BNSS against the accused on or before the next date of hearing.
