

Jaggu through LRs Jagir Singh Vs State of Haryana 1

Fresh memo of appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 filed.

2. Present execution has been filed by the applicants/award holders through LRs for release of compensation deposited by JDs.

3. On 08.03.2026, the Ahlmad has reported that an amount of Rs.24,24,115/- has been deposited by the JDs in LAC No.297 of 2007 in the name of Jaggu son of Jyot Ram vide RD No.2658 dated 22.01.2026. During the pendency of RFA No.2792/2010, award holder Jaggu son of Jyot Ram died and the applicants Jagir Singh and Sikander Lal were impleaded as the legal heirs of deceased award holder Jaggu in Exe-484-2021 vide order dated 14.07.2022 passed by Sh. Sunil Kumar-II the then Ld. ASJ, Panchkula..

4. On 25.05.2026, the Lrs of applicants/award holders Jagir Singh and Sikander Lal filed their joint affidavits Ex.P2 and Ex.P3 in support of their claim alongwith security bond Ex.P1.

5. On 25.05.2026 Shri Amit Syan, Patwari appeared and suffered the following statement:-

*“Stated that in this case compensation money of Rs. 24,24,115/- has been deposited in the name of original award holder late Sh. Jaggu in LAC no. 297/2007 and RFA No. 2792/2010. Copy of the payment schedule is Ex-R1. Out of the said compensation. Hon’ble High court has enhanced the compensation to Rs.1290 per square yard in terms of main judgment dated 13.12.2018 rendered in RFA 1935 of 2009 titled Kali Charan Vs. State of Haryana. Hon’ble Supreme Court in SLPs filed by the State vide Diary No.41974/2019 titled as “State of Haryana Vs. Kali Charan etc. etc., vide order dated 17.12.2019 passed the following order:-*

*“Issue notice on the application(s) for condonation of delay has also on the Special Leave Petition (s).*

*Dasti, in addition, is permitted.*

*Tag with Special Leave Petition (c) No.10215-10219/2019 and Diary No. 30302/2019 and other connect cases, if any.*

*In the meantime, the execution proceedings shall remain stayed subject to the State making the payment of the compensation at the rate of Rs. 746/- per square yard as has been paid in the case of "Lokinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Haryana & Ors".*

*On payment of the aforesaid compensation, the execution proceedings shall not be proceeded with. We, however, observe that payments made under this order shall abide by the result of the petitions.*

*Learned counsel for the land owners shall withdraw half of the amount without security and half of the amount with security".*

*The JD has no objection for releasing the compensation of Rs.24,24,115/- deposited in the name of award holder Jaggu now deceased th. His LRs. Jagir Singh & Sikander Lal to are already impleaded LRs. Of late Sh. Jaggu vide order dt. 14.07.2022. The said compensation of Rs. 24,24,115/- may be released in their favor on furnishing security of half of the compensation money to be released as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court which is already reproduce above.*

*The aforesaid compensation has been deposited in compliance of interim order of Hon'ble Supreme court @ Rs. 746 per square yard as mention in the SLP vide diary No. 41974 of 2019 and the compensation @ Rs. 340 per square yard of the reference court award has already been adjusted from the compensation of Rs. 746 per square yard.*

6.                On 25.05.2026, learned counsel for the decree holder has suffered a statement to the following effect:-

*"Stated that in lieu of the statement made by Sh. Amit Syan Patwari for the JDs, recorded before this Hon'ble court today, I withdraw the present execution fully satisfied subject to all just exceptions. Hence the compensation amount deposited by the JDs. may be released by issuing voucher".*

7.                In the view of the aforesaid circumstances and statements of parties/counsel and report of the Ahlmad and in view of the order dated 17.12.2019 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India referred to above, the Ahlmad concerned is directed to issue the refund voucher of the amount of **Rs.24,24,115/- (Rs.12,12,057/- each to both applicants namely Jagir Singh and Sikander Lal) with 50 % security each** in favour of the award holders Jagir Singh and Sikander Lal in **equal shares** against proper receipt and identification. **An intimation regarding security furnished by applicants be sent to the concerned Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar/Revenue**
