Summons issued to the accused received back with the report of adampata. Complainant has suffered a statement that the address mentioned in the complaint is last known address of accused. It is important to mention here that Hon'ble Supreme Court in citation titled as "Ajeet Seeds Ltd. VS K. Gopala Krishnaiah" has observed that *"Section 27 of General Clause Act gives rise to a presumption that services of notice has been effected when it is sent to the correct address by registered post"*. So it is considered as valid service against accused. It shows that accused has due knowledge about pendency of the present complaint. In view of these circumstances, this court has sufficient grounds to presume that further coercive method is required to be adopted for ensuring the presence of the accused. Accordingly, his **bailable warrants** in the sum of Rs.5000/- with one surety in the like amount be issued for 14.08.2026.
