Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused persons namely- **1) Muktar Saha, 2) Aktar Saha, 3) Sirajul Saha and 4) Joytunnesa Saha** are found not guilty to the charges punishable **u/s 498A and u/s 304B of the IPC** and they are hereby acquitted from this case under section 235(1) of Cr.P.C.

The accused persons are discharged from their bail bonds.

Sureties be also discharged.

Let them be set free at once.

The seized 'alamats' in this case be dealt with accordingly after expiry of the appeal period and if no appeal is preferred.

Let a copy of this judgment be sent to the Secretary, DLSA Tamruk, Purba Mednipur, in view of the requirement of compliance with the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed in Sabitri Bhunya vs State of West Bengal and another dated 29.03.22 and the Secretary DLSA is requested to act accordingly. B.C I to comply.

Let the provision of section 365 of Cr.P.C be complied with and a copy of this judgment be sent to the DM concerned for his information.

Let the Judgment and order be uploaded in the CIS of this court. B.C I to comply at once.
