Order No.17 dated 15.07.2026

Today is fixed for evidence.

Both the parties are present by filing hajira through Ld. Advocates. It appears from the record that summon was served upon OP No.1-owner of the offending vehicle but he did not turn up to contest the suit. Accordingly, the suit be proceeded ex-parte against OP No.1.

At this stage, Ld. Advocate for the Insurance Company files an application u/s 170 of MV Act. Copy served. Prayer is allowed for ends of justice.

The claimant Keshab Roy and eye witness Dilip Roy are present. They are examined and cross-examined in full as PW 1 & 2 and discharged. Some documents are marked as exhibits.

Ld. Advocates for the claimant submitted to adduce further evidence.

Prayer is allowed.
