ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR RETURN OF PROPERTY

The present application is filed by the applicant/ original complainant viz. **Mrs. Pooja Sandesh Upale** to defreeze the account of the accused of **Kotak Mahindra Bank**, account No. 9946204022, IFSC Code KKBK0001368, to the extent of Rs. 792/-, **UCO Bank**, account no. 02280110091135, IFSC Code UCBA0003415, to the extent of Rs. 42,046/-, **Canara Bank**, account no. 2695101004683, IFSC Code CNRB00000033, to the extent of Rs. 5,344/-, **Kotak Mahindra Bank**, account no. 6413648822, IFSC Code KKBK0001368, to the extent of Rs. 5,146/-, **Kotak Mahindra Bank**, account no. 4548660689, IFSC Code KKBK0001368, to the extent of Rs. 3,753/-, **Indian Overseas Bank**, account no. 174701000020905, IFSC Code IOBA0001747, to the extent of Rs. 142/-, **Mobikwick**, account no. 919462992052, to the extent of Rs. 2,353/- and return the above said cash lying in the account of accused. Say of I.O was called. Application is supported with copy of Bank Statement and Adhar card.

2. I have gone through the application and say filed by I.O. I have gone through the documents filed by the applicant on record. Prima-facie it appears that applicant has proved her claim and entitlement to the extent of amount frozen in the account of accused by the bank. Therefore, no prejudice would be caused to prosecution, if the amount was set to be released in the account of applicant/complainant. Hence, considering the facts and

circumstances, in my considered view, applicant is entitled to receive the amount which has been freeze in the account of the accused. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following order :-

ORDER

- i. The application filed by the applicant / original complainant is hereby allowed.
- ii. The officer in charge / I.O. of Kurar Police Station shall defreeze the account of the accused of **abovesaid bank** and directing the concerned bank to release/transfer the said amount in the bank account of applicant/complainant **Malad Sahakari Bank Ltd., account No. 003022100025134, IFSC Code TMSB0000003, to the extent of Rs. 59,576/-**.
- iii. The concerned Bank Manager/ Nodal Officer is hereby directed to reverse the amount from above said bank account of the accused and credit in the bank account of the applicant i.e **Malad Sahakari Bank Ltd., account No. 003022100025134, IFSC Code TMSB0000003, to the extent of Rs. 59,576/-**.
