Today is fixed for passing order, hence, record is taken up.

Perused the case record.

This is an application under Sec. 28 of the Special Marriage Act filed on 15.12.2022.

Parties were married on 02.12.2009 under the provisions of Special Marriage Act, 1954 at the office of Registrar at Jorasanko, Amherst Street, Manicktala, Muchipara, Kol-700009 and both started residing together as husband and wife at the house of petitioner No. 1/husband and two children namely, Saathvik Roy, born on 14.02.2014 and Sourish Roy, born on 19.07.2018. But due to differences of temperament, taste, thoughts and increasing incompatibility etc. the relationship between the parties deteriorated with the passage of time. Several reconciliations were held between the parties but all went in vain. As a result they started residing separately since 01.03.2021. Thus, petitioners have mutually agreed to dissolve their marriage by a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

Petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 were examined as P.W.1 and P.W.2 respectively. Original Marriage Registration certificate is marked as Exbt. 1.

All the statutory requirements stand satisfied.

C.F. paid is correct.

Hence, let the application for mutual divorce be allowed.

Accordingly, it is,

Ordered

That the application for mutual divorce under Sec. 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 is hereby allowed.

The marriage between the petitioner No. 1 Sudip Kumar Roy and the petitioner No. 2 Sinthia Roy solemnized on 02.12.2009 is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent under Sec. 28 of the Special Marriage Act with effect from this date.

Same order be communicated to the concerned Marriage Registrar for necessary noting at the register.
