Order No.02 dt. 01.08.2026 :

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner, namely, **Dilip Samanta** praying for anticipatory bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case and had no role in the alleged offence. Charge sheet has already been submitted. All accused persons are on bail except this accused-petitioner. As such, he has prayed for anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. P.P refers the C.D and raises strong objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 of B.N.S.S. and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. It appears from the case record that the investigation has already been completed by submitting charge sheet showing the accused-petitioner as absconder.

Considering the materials on record, nature and gravity of the offence and the conduct of the accused-petitioner, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this accused-petitioner namely, **Dilip Samanta** is **rejected**.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.
