**Order No.3 dated 13.03.2026**

The application for anticipatory bail for the above named accused petitioners U/s.482 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners prays for anticipatory bail on the ground that the accused petitioners have been implicated on exaggerated allegation.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

I have gone through the statement of the alleged injured U/s.180 of BNSS as well the Medical document, namely, Injury report.

On careful perusal of the F.I.R. and statement of witnesses, it appears that the allegation of assault is mainly against the present accused petitioner No.1. Sukchand Sk. @ Shukchand Sk. and, in view of above, prayer for anticipatory bail of accused petitioner **No.1. Sukchand Sk. @ Shukchand Sk.** stands **rejected.**

With regard to the prayer for anticipatory bail in respect of the accused petitioner No.2, 3 and 4, considering the role played by them, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the present accused petitioner No.2, 3 and 4 is not necessary for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer of the accused petitioner **No.2, 3 and 4** for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS stands **allowed.**

Hence, in the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner **No.2, 3 and 4**, in connection with above noted P.S. case, with regard to the incident complained of, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer.

If released on anticipatory bail, the accused petitioner **No.2, 3 and 4** shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482 (2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
