The application for anticipatory bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.482 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail by referring to the Medical documents in the C.D.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

The allegation made in the F.I.R. is grave and serious in nature.

I have carefully gone through the Medical documents including the Injury reports at page No.14, 15, 63, 64 etc. of the C.D. which depict that the victim sustained fracture injury which is grievous in nature.

The Medical documents also show that the victim sustained injury on his eye.

On careful perusal of the F.I.R. and statement of witnesses U/s.180 of BNSS including that of the alleged injured victim, it prima facie appears that the present accused petitioner is the **principal accused** against whom allegation of assault is there.

Considering the nature and gravity of offence alleged, materials in C.D., involvement of the accused and also considering the severity of punished prescribed, I am of the opinion that this is not a fit case to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS stands **rejected**.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
