

State Vs. Sanamdeep Singh.

1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed on behalf of accused Sanamdeep Singh.
2. In the bail, Ahlmad has reported that as per CIS, this is the first bail application of accused pertaining to abovesaid FIR.
3. In the application, it is stated that no recovery was affected from the accused/applicant and the accused/applicant have been falsely implicated by the police and he is innocent and have committed no offence. As such, learned counsel for accused has prayed for release the accused on bail.
4. Notice of the application was given to Ld. APP, who verbally contested the application stating that accused does not deserve the concession of bail. However, he also informed the Court that no such bail application of accused is pending or decided by any Court till date.
5. **Perusal of the file reveals that accused/applicant Sanamdeep Singh has been arrested on 19.08.2024 and since then he is in custody.** Recovery, if any, must have been effected and no previous record of conviction of accused/applicant has been placed on record. Since, the challan has already presented and recovery if any has already been effected and conclusion of trial will take long time, No useful purpose shall be sought by keeping the accused behind the bars for indefinitely

period. Accordingly, accused/applicant Sanamdeep Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the tune of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Accordingly bail application stands allowed. Bonds accordingly have not been furnished. Papers be attached with the main file.
