Order No.3 dated 05.03.2026

The application for anticipatory bail for the above named accused petitioners U/s.482 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The present case arose out of free fighting between two groups and over the self same incident another case has been lodged by the present accused party against the defacto complainant party vide Berhampore P.S. case No.275/2026 dated 13.02.2026.

I have carefully perused the materials in case record and the C.D., including the F.I.R., statement of the witnesses including that of the alleged victim U/s.180 of BNSS.

The Medical documents including the Injury report show that the injuries allegedly sustained by the victims, are simple in nature.

In view of above and other materials in C.D., I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the present accused persons is not necessary for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioners for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS stands **allowed.**

Hence, in the event of arrest of the above named petitioners in connection with above noted P.S. case, with regard to the incident complained of, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer.

If released on anticipatory bail, the petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482 (2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
